### Herbarium Techniques

Children have collected a considerable number of herbal medicinal plant samples and documented their local/colloquial names, their usages and methods of use. They have collected around 409 specimens of herbal plants all through ANI.

These Health related activities could create awareness at community level, negotiate with the health systems and worked towards making the government machineries accountable to provide optimum health services at the community level. Government officials have regularly participated in health education programmes and extended support by providing BCC materials. Gradually children have been raising health related issues amongst others in Bal Sabhas and children's club meetings at their CDCs.
