PUC is a letter dated 1st May'2007 received from the Assistant Commissioner (HQ), Office of the Deputy Commissioner, South Andaman regarding demand of Justice against Denial of Tribal Pass u/s of PAT Regulations, 1956 on purported ground that the department of Tribal Welfare chose not recommend my case, but not disclosing why they did not.

In response to our letter dated 27/4/07 at page 95/c the Assistant Commissioner (HQ) has stated that the tribal pass was not issued to Shri Randhir Kumar De, as the department of Tribal Welfare has not recommended the case of the applicant, and the same may be communicated to Shri R.K. De.

In this context, it is submitted that DC, South Andaman is the competent authority to consider the tribal pass. He had sought the comments of the Secretary (TW) as to whether tribal pass can be given to applicant Shri R.K.De vide his letter dated 4th December'2006 at page 92/c. In reply to which the ES, AAJVS had given his comments with the approval of Secretary (TW) to DC, South Andamans vide letter dated 8.12.2006 at page 93/c. As the DC, South Andamans is the competent authority to Consider & Issue tribal pass under Section 7 of A&N Islands (PAT Regulation) 1956, he may communicate the matter to the applicant i.e. Shri R.K De.

Accordingly, if approved we may write to DC, South Andamans on the above lines.
