

- 1) The maintenance work should be carried out under the overall supervision of Executive Secretary, AAJVS.
- 2) The team should be escorted with AAJVS officials and Police personnel.
- 3) The team should complete maintenance work before 2:00 PM and shall leave the Jarawa Reserve Area before 3:00 PM. They should enter the time of entry and departure in the log book maintained by the Police.
- 4) The team should deposit the mobile phone or any camera with the Police Outpost, Jirkatang. No photography shall be allowed in the Jarawa Reserve Area. The team should ensure that no cigarette, alcohol, match box or any other inflammable articles should be carried in the Jarawa Reserve Area.
- 5) No undue interference in the lives of Jarawas tribes during the course of maintenance

The request to carry out the maintenance work in the Jarawa Reserve area on as and when fault occurs in Jarawa area due to natural calamity or damage due to some external or damage cannot be considered in the interest of the tribes. Only one time exemption will be granted at a time. The BSNL may approach to this department for seeking permission, as and when it is felt necessitate to carry out the maintenance work in the Jarawa Reserve Area.
