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EDUCATION SUB PLAN FOR TRIBAL AREAS
OF ANDHRA PRADESH

INTRODUCTION :-

EDUCATION in Tribal areas mainly suffers from the triple problems of Absenteeism, Wastage and Stagnation. The low literacy rate of 5.3% among Scheduled Tribes in comparison to State general literacy rate of 24.6% (1971 Census) is mainly the result of improper coverage on one hand and non-utilisation of existing institutions by the tribals on the others. Studies conducted into the problems of tribal education in Andhra Pradesh have revealed that children do not attend the schools due to various reasons. Grown up male children are economic assets to the family as they start assisting the parents ever since they attain 7 years of age in the family economic pursuits. Consequently either they drop out from the school or do not join school at all. In the case of school going girls the few that attend classes are frequently retained by parents to look after the younger children. Often the parents do not agree to send their grown up girls to schools after they attain puberty. Hence they too dropped out from schools. Similarly various other socio-economic reasons contributed to the high incidence of absenteeism and stagnation.

The performance of the single teacher schools as revealed in a study, was dismal as teachers very often stayed out of these villages due to various reasons. As an experiment Ashram Schools have been started by providing boarding and lodging facilities to tribal children. Once these children are no more burden on the tribal parents, they did not hesitate to send their children to Ashram Schools by fore going income from children's earnings.

Comparitive study of performances of residential and non-residential schools has shown that wastage and stagnation are low in residential schools. While the percentage of wastage in non-residential schools is 73.0%, it is only 57.92% in Ashram Schools and the stagnation index is only 32.85 in residential school in comparison to 45.75 in non-residential schools. Encouraged by the results in Ashram Schools, the Government of Andhra Pradesh have decided to merge single teacher schools run by Tribal Welfare Department into centralised Ashram Schools. However, the high cost in providing Ashram School education has necessitated the Government to think twice before starting Ashram Schools in more numbers.

Enquiries into the working of reorganised Ashram Schools have revealed that they too did not ensure proper coverage. The girls' education was

not properly taken care of as there is no clear provision to admit them into Ashram Schools as inmates nor separate Ashram Schools are started for girls. The general population which should have been covered under minimum needs programme do not get admission into these residential schools as they are opened exclusively for tribals. A study conducted into the functioning of reorganised schools also confirmed the findings. Consequently in the Sub Plan and Integrated Tribal Development Project exercises in the V Plan period, a modified approach has been evolved to ensure enrolling of 100% boys and 80% girls of school age in the age group of 6 - 11 years. Ashram Schools have been proposed for clusters of small and isolated villages and primary schools for big villages with more than 300 population. Upper primary schools, High Schools and Hostels are proposed after estimating the flow of student population by deducting the probable drop outs due to absenteeism and stagnation.

I. Specific targets of enrolment and special programme for achieving them in the year 1977-78:

PRIMARY SCHOOLS: At present there are 1768 Primary Schools and 222 Ashram Schools in the Sub Plan areas of the State. Of the estimated school age children of 2,28,651 in the age group of 6 - 11 years, 1,07,440 constituting 46.99% are covered by these primary schools.

To achieve the target of enrolling 100% school age boys and 80% school age girls, 98,346 tribal children are further to be covered. To achieve this coverage it is proposed to start ordinary primary schools in school less centres to cover 64,016 students the remaining being covered by Ashram Schools proposed (Statement I).

ASHRAM SCHOOLS: Village-wise literacy figures have been collected from the census hand books for all villages in the Sub Plan area. A study of the availability of facilities to these villages has shown that areas characterised by small villages are most backward with in the backward tribal areas. The literacy level is not more than 1% in these willages. As each village cannot sustain a school by itself and with a view to remove the burden of feeding the school going child by the poor parent of these most backward areas, Ashram Schools have been proposed to be established for clusters of such small villages.

At present there are 222 Ashram Schools in Sub Plan area with an enrolment of 12,541. It is proposed to establish 292 Ashram Schools to cover 33,330 tribal children. The meso level sub plan area in Visakhapatnam presents a peculiar problem where small villages are very high in number and it is possible to provide primary education only through establishment of 131 Ashram Schools with

a strength of 200 per school. In other meso level tribal areas Ashram Schools with a strength of 40 each were proposed (Statement II).

As such by the end of V Plan period, 2,05,786 of the 2,28,651 Primary School age children would be covered thus ensuring 90% coverage.

H O S T E L S:- About 96 hostels are functioning in the sub plan area. It is estimated that 2400 more tribal children require hostel facilities in the V Plan period and to cater to their needs 60 new hostels have been proposed at upper primary and higher secondary level to absorb more number of students (Statement V).

II. Steps necessary for removing structural imbalances at middle and secondary level:

There should be one Upper Primary School for every six existing Primary Schools as per the norm followed by the dept in which case 325 Upper Primary Schools are required. Whereas only 115 are in existence. The district-wise Upper Primary Schools required as per norm and Upper Primary Schools proposed as per the actual requirements calculated on the basis of successful candidates from primary level are given hereunder.

In view of the large number of upper primary and high schools already existing in other I.T.D.P. areas only one high school is proposed in East Godavari district and 11 in Srikakulam district project area during V plan period (Stat.IV).

III. Identification of more sparsely populated areas for taking up Ashram Schools upto Higher Secondary level

Because of sparseness of tribal population in sub plan area, the density of population in Scheduled areas is only 46 against 157 in the state as a whole. The I.P.D.A. wise density of population is given hereunder:

With in the I.T.D.A areas, there are more sparsely populated areas characterised by small villages with 300 and below population. These have been identified in the I.T.D.A. exercises and for clusters of such small villages, Ashram Schools have been proposed. Largest number of Ashram Schools are proposed in Visakhapatnam district where nearly 60% of the villages have below 300 population.

IV. Identification of priority areas with extremely low levels of literacy for special attention:

In the first stage sparsely populated areas have been identified for proposing Ashram Schools. With in these areas, villages inhabited by backward tribal groups like Savara in Srikakulam district, Konda Dora, Gadaba and Samantha in Visakhapatnam district, Konda Reddi in East and West Godavari districts and Khammam district and Kolam and Thoti in Adilabad district are identified

as priority areas as literacy among tribes living in these areas is less than 1%. Preference will be given to these areas while starting Ashram Schools.

V. Innovative Programmes:

Forming Husband - wife teams for taking up combined pre-primary and primary education programme is to be examined in depth. The husband will be assigned teaching while the wife works for inculcation of school going habit to pre-primary children. It is to be verified how many of the wives of teachers are educated to perform this duty. Again a conscious effort is being made to appoint as many tribal candidates available as teachers., in which case very few of their spouses are educated. Thirdly, the special nutrition centres are presently organised regularly by employed personnel and transferring of management of these SNP centres to the wives of teachers may not be possible due to administrative reasons.

Further, in some places like Uttoor P.D. Block area, Nutrition programme is integrated with other aspects of child care in Integrated Child Development Services Scheme with Angan Wadi worker as the Coordinator at village level. Thus in such areas integrating nutrition programme with education programme may not be feasible as it is already integrated with health programme. However, as an experiment this scheme may

be started in selected areas by paying Rs. 25/- per month as stipend to the spouses of the teacher. The total cost of the schemes if implemented in toto is as follows:

VI. Special Programmes for girls education in Selected areas:

Literacy rate among females is very low and the enrolment of female children is also not encouraging. The district wise enrolment of female children in the age group of 6 - 11 years is given hereunder:

While this is the case with girls primary education, in classes VI to X, only 18.33% of the school going children are girls (Statement VI).

One of the important programmes suggested for increased enrolment of girls is award of attendance scholarships to girls @ Rs. 40/- per pupil per annum. This is given normally in the form of uniforms to girls students maintaining good attendance. Besides, the Departments programme already includes opening of hostels and Ashram Schools exclusively for girls. The programme should include construction of staff quarters to teachers so as to encourage the female teachers to stay in the village only. Provision has already been made for teacher quarters along with schools.

VII. CITIZEN AND NON-FORMAL EDUCATION PROGRAMME:

Illiteracy among tribals cannot be tackled by starting various types of schools for school age children only. The problem is to be tackled by a support programme for Adult Literacy. While steps necessary to enroll more children will be taken it is also necessary to start non-formal education to educate the adult tribals.

PROGRAMME:- The education department with their experience in running non-formal education centres in two plains districts of Andhra Pradesh propose to cover sub-plan areas with modified themes to suit the tribal areas. There will be one centre for each village having a primary school or Ashram School to provide non-formal education to drop outs, non-enrolled and

un-educated adult tribals. One of the educated tribals in the village will be appointed as Instructor after providing him necessary coaching under the guidance of State Council of Educational Research and Training. He is to be paid a honorarium of Rs. 50/- per month.

For every 10 centres, there shall be a Supervisor, a Headmaster of Upper Primary School of the area who, is to be paid honorarium of Rs. 60/- per month. The Supervisors will be given orientation training at State Council of Educational Research and Training, Hyderabad as they prepared syllabus and organised such courses for Supervisors functioning in the two plains Districts.

The themes identified includes constitution of India, Panchayats, Agricultural Development (Use of inputs etc), Family Planning, Cottage and Small Scale Industries, Savings, etc. For Sub-Plan areas, the themes will be modified such as teaching constitutional guarantees for tribals and protective regulations, need for developing the habit of thrift etc. The curriculum, syllabus and reading material are to be prepared in consultation with the Director, Adult and Continuing Education of Andhra University.

In the remaining two years of V plan period, the scheme will be started only in two Districts of

Sub-Plan namely Visakhaptnam and Adilabad with 150 Centres in each district. The cost of scheme per district is as follows:

VII. SPECIAL EDUCATIONAL PROGRAMMES AROUND INDUSTRIAL AND MINING COMPLEXES.

The facilities in existing mining and industrial training institutions have been increased for encouraging tribal students to join these institutions. For example, a separate hostel was attached to the training institute at Visakhapatnam besides reserving seats in these institutions for Scheduled Tribe candidates.

IX. STREAM LINING AND REINFORCING THE ADMINISTRATION OF EDUCATIONAL INSTITUTIONS:

It is proposed to organise the total sub plan areas into three education districts and District Educational Officers are to be appointed exclusively for tribal areas. The tribal areas of Srikakulam and Visakhapatnam forming one District, that of East Godavari, West Godavari and Khammam another district and those of Warangal and Adilabad Districts forming third education district.

In each of the Tribal Development Blocks, there are only two Officers supervising the educational programme i.e., the Deputy Inspector of Schools and Extension Officer (Education). Because of the long distances they have to cover in each Block, mostly on foot, the coverage was poor. To ensure full coverage of areas for Supervision, one more Deputy Inspector of Schools will be posted in all 24 T.D.Blocks.

In Community Development Blocks, one Deputy Inspector of School per Block for Sub Plan areas within C.D. Block area will also be appointed.

The District Educational Officers appointed will be directly under the administrative control of Tribal Welfare Department, and will be overall incharge of tribal education in his district. He will be a liason Officer between Education Department and Tribal Welfare Department and will be implementing his programmes in coordination with the normal District Educational Officers.

The total cost of the scheme for remaining two years works out to Rs. 4,14,000.
