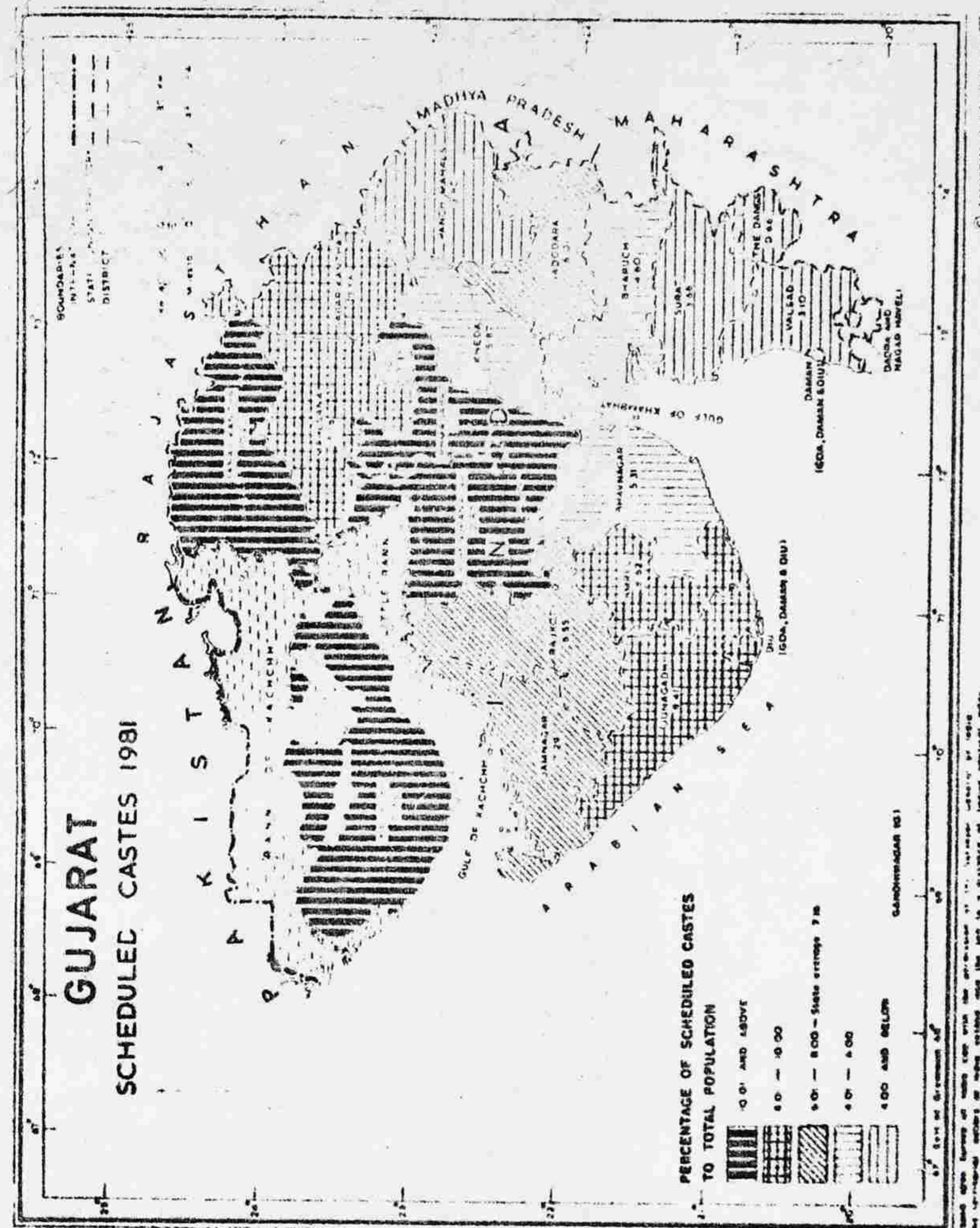

CONSTITUTIONAL PROVISIONS FOR S.C.

Our nation has pledged to root the evil of untouchability. Article 15(1), 17 and 38 of the Constitution of India give a mandate to the States in this regard. The Untouchability (Offences) Act, 1955 which was later on amended in 1976 as the Protection of Civil Rights Act, provides for various legal measures to see that the untouchables enjoy fully their civil rights as free citizens of the country. The Central and State Government are also implementation of the constitutional/legal provisions. It is a matter of great regret that after four decades of independence, the Nation has not as yet been able to root out this evil.

Constitutional Provisions:

Article 15: of the Constitution declares that "(1) The State shall not discriminate against any citizen on ^{only} grounds of religion, race, caste, sex, place of birth or any of them. (2) No citizen shall on grounds only on religion, race, caste, sex, place of birth, or any of them be subject to any disability, liability, restriction or condition. With regard to (a) access to shop, public restaurants, hotels and places of public entertainment, or (b) the use of wells, tanks, bathing ghats, roads and places of public resort maintained wholly or partly out of State funds."

The First Amendment to the Constitution, passed in 1951 adds that :

(4) "Nothing in this Article (15)...shall prevent the state from making any special provision for the advancement of any socially and educationally backward classes of citizens or for the scheduled castes and scheduled tribes."

(3) Nothing in this article shall prevent the State from making any special provision for women and children.

Article 17: deals with the abolition of untouchability.

It reads:

"Untouchability is abolished and its practice in any form is forbidden. The enforcement of any disability arising out of untouchability shall be an offence punishable in accordance with law."

Article 38: The State shall strive to promote the welfare of the people by securing and protecting as effectively as it may a social order in which justice, social, economic and political, shall inform all the institutions of the national life.

Article 46: Promotion of educational and economic interests of scheduled castes, scheduled tribes and other weaker sections.

"The State shall promote with special care the educational and economic interests of the weaker sections

of the people, and, in particular, of the scheduled castes and the scheduled tribes, and shall protect them from social injustice and all forms of exploitation."

Article 330: Reservation of seats for scheduled castes and scheduled tribes in the House of the People.

(1) Seats shall be reserved in the House of the People for -

(a) Scheduled Castes

(b) Scheduled Tribes (except the Scheduled Tribes in the tribal areas of Assam and in Nagaland) and

(c) the Scheduled Tribes in the autonomous districts of Assam.

(2) The number of seats reserved in any State (or Union Territory) for the Scheduled Castes or the Scheduled Tribes under Clause (1) shall bear as nearly as may be, the same proportion to the total number of seats allotted to that state (or Union Territory) in the House of the People as the population of the Scheduled Castes in the State (or Union Territory) or of the Scheduled Tribes in the State (or Union Territory) or part of the State (or Union Territory) as the case may be, in respect of which seats are so reserved, bears to the total population of the State (or Union Territory).

Article 332: Reservation of seats for scheduled castes and scheduled tribes in the Legislative Assemblies of the States -

(1) Seats shall be reserved for the Scheduled Castes and the Scheduled Tribes (except the Scheduled Tribes in the tribal areas of Assam and in Nagaland) in the Legislative Assembly of every State.

(2) Seats shall be reserved also for the Autonomous districts in the Legislative Assembly of the State of Assam.

(3) The number of seats reserved for the Scheduled Castes or the Scheduled Tribes in the Legislative Assembly of any State under clause (i) shall bear, as nearly as may be, the same proportion to the total number of seats in the Assembly as the population of the Scheduled Castes in the State or of the Scheduled Tribes in the State or part of the States, as the case may be, in respect of which seats are so reserved, bears to the population of the State.

(4) The number of seats reserved for an autonomous district in the Legislative Assembly of the State of Assam shall bear to the total number of seats in that Assembly a proportion not less than the population of the district bears to the total population of the State.

(5) The constituencies for the seats reserved for any autonomous district of Assam shall not comprise any area outside that district.

(6) No person who is not a member of a Scheduled Tribe or any autonomous district of the State of Assam shall be eligible for election to the Legislative Assembly of the State from any constituency of that district.

Article 335: Claims of Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes to services and posts.

The claims of the members of the Scheduled Castes and the Scheduled Tribes shall be taken into consideration, consistently with the maintenance of efficiency of administration, in the making of appointments to services and posts in connection with the affairs of the Union or of a State.

Article 338: Special Officer for Scheduled Castes, Scheduled Tribes, etc.

(1) There shall be a Special Officer for the Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes to be appointed by the President.

(2) It shall be the duty of the Special Officer to investigate all matters relating to the safeguards provided for the Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes under this constitution and report to the President upon the working of those safeguards at such intervals as the President may direct, and the President shall cause all such reports to be laid before each House of Parliament.

(3) In this article references to the Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes shall be construed as including references to such other backward classes as the President may, on receipt of the report of a Commission appointed under Clause (1) of Article 340, by order specify and also to the Anglo-Indian community.

Article 341: Scheduled Castes.

(1) The President may with respect to any State, or Union Territory, and where it is a State, after consultation with the Governor thereof by public notification, specify the castes, races or tribes or parts of or groups within castes, races or tribes which shall for the purposes of this Constitution be deemed to be Scheduled Castes in relation to that State or Union Territory, as the case may be.

(2) Parliament may by law include in or exclude from the list of Scheduled Castes specified in a notification issued under clause (1) any caste, race or tribe or part of or group within any caste, race or tribe, but save as aforesaid a notification issued under the said clause shall not be varied by any subsequent notification.

Article 342: Definitions.

In this Constitution unless the context otherwise requires, the following expressions have the meanings hereby respectively assigned to them that is to say -

(24) "Scheduled Castes" means such castes, races or tribes or part of or groups within such castes, races or tribes as are deemed under Article 341 to be Scheduled Castes for the purpose of this Constitution.
