9. The members of the team shall not think that the primitive tribes are the people to be observed as the zoo animals.
10. The members of the team shall not collect anything from the tribal areas like shells, ornaments or even piece of wood.
11. The members of the team shall make individual observation/study of the tribals during the contact and these observations could be discussed/shared by other members on board the vessel/on return from the expedition.
12. The team shall give the gifts which are approved by the Lt. Governor. These gifts are given as a gesture of friendship and not with a motive to feed the tribals.
13. No member of the team shall give away any kind of gifts and eatables to the tribals.
14. No member of the team shall use or give any intoxication item like bettle nut, tobacco, liquor etc. during the contact.
15. No member of the team including the police shall use any kind of force/coercion against the tribals during the contact visit.
16. No fire power shall be used by the police or anyone during the contact.
17. During extremely dire situation where- in the lives of the members of the contact team are at stake, the Commander of the team only may order the use of the fire power in air repeat in air and never against the tribals that too only to scare them away. In no case the tribals are to be affected by the use of fire power. In this context it may be remembered that the contact expedition to the tribals is to further the friendly
