This time fogging by malaria team done within and also DDT spray on 24th December 2008 done by Malaria team.

During the medical coverage it has been observed that all the spurious liquor poison cases are safe. No one is having vision problem even Totonage 45 years, Vickey 14 years have recovered completely at Primary Health Centre Hut Bay, Little Andaman. Further, Totanagae is having vision problem cuase other than spurious liquor poisioning but hypermetropia.
