Sub: Intensifying patrolling in Jarawa area- reg.

Sir,

I am directed to state that the Chief Secretary accompanied by Senior Officers of A&N Administration visited Jarawa areas of Kadamtala, and Middle Strait on 30th October 2009 and Tirur on 2nd November 2009. Copy of tour note is enclosed herewith for kind perusal please.

The Chief Secretary directed that the departments concerned may increase their patrolling in the territory to contain hunting, poaching and fishing activities by non-tribals.

It is to mention here that three task force committees have already been constituted for Tirur, Middle Strait and Kadamtala areas consisting of Officers from Forest, Police and AAJVS for patrolling and anti-poaching activities.

It is requested to kindly direct the Officers concerned from your respective departments to intensify the coordinated joint patrolling activities frequently to prevent poaching / hunting activities in the Jarawa areas. They may also be directed to submit monthly progress report in this regard.
