It was reported that the existing Pharmacist Shri. Nokaiah left Dugong Creek on transfer to G.B. Pant Hospital and his reliever would report for duty on 16th May 2011. The ANM Ms. Jayanti Mondal is on maternity leave. Reliever is awaited.

A new Guest house has been constructed. It has one VIP room and three ordinary rooms. Despite depositing funds of Rs. 5,85,638/- with APWD and Electricity department the following three works is yet to be executed:-

- a) Furnishing the guest house
- b) Extension of energy service line
- c) Repair of cyclone damaged roof (replacement of sheets)

Inspected the medical sub centre. The Medical Officer from PHC R.K. Pur visits Dugong Creek every month. He visited on 14th April 2011.

Thereafter visited the power house. The engine driver informed that the timing of power supply is from 5 PM to 5 AM. There are three diesel generator sets two of 20 KVA and one with 18.75 KV. One set has minor problems and request has been made for its repairs.

Proceeded to Government School. There are two teachers in the School. The teacher-in-Charge informed that the School has been upgraded to Middle School from this academic session. There are 14 admissions of standard 6th. The school requires additional teacher, room and furniture for standard 6th. It is seen that the Onges school going children are not wearing shoes and socks. The teacher informed that the Education department provides free uniform and books but these two items are not provided by the department.

The kitchen for preparation of mid day meals was inspected and it is observed that it is neat and clean and hygienic. It was observed that kitchidi is being prepared for the children. The scale of distribution of mid day meals is 100 grams of rice for students up to class 5th and above class 5th 150 grams of rice per day. The required ration items are provided by the Onges Multi Purpose Co-operative Society (OMPCS ltd)
