

- 6) Septic tanks, sewage line and drainage has to be constructed for the 11 number houses for Great Andamanese
- 7) 10 houses out of the 11 number Great Andamanese houses have been completed. One house requires bathroom fitting. Service line and water supply connection has to be extended for all the 11 houses.

After inspection of the site, a meeting was convened in the guest house attended by the Great Andamanese and the Government employees.

- 1) There are two computers in the School at Strait Island. The School vacation commence from 15<sup>th</sup> May 2011. Hence, the Great Andamanese were requested to utilize this time and to send their children, who are at Strait island on vacation, to the School at Strait island for learning basic computer education.
- 2) The Great Andamanese were informed that the AAJVS is eager to provide best possible education and facilities to their children, hence they may not withdraw their wards from the school for any reason.
- 3) The Junior Engineer, APWD informed that his department is unable to handover the buildings as they have to make payment to contractor. APWD is preparing the revised estimates.
- 4) It is known that ES, AAJVS has information that liquor is reaching Strait island by various sources. The Great Andamanese board the ferry boats and collect liquor bottles from vendors / vegetable sellers, consume on board and carry in their luggage. This goes unchecked. The Police Personnel on duty were requested to check all the baggage being unloaded at Strait Island including the tribal luggage.
