**Sub:- Conditional Order for removal of a dead Gurjan tree standing behind  
Primary School, Great Andamanese Settlement, Strait Island - reg.**

Sir,

Enclosed herewith please find conditional order dated 14-11-2011 in Case No.76/2011 under Section 133/Cr.P.C and subsequent corrigendum order dated 12-1-2012 in the same case issued by the Sub Divisional Magistrate, South Andaman.

The Social Worker In-charge, AAJVS, Strait Island has informed that the Range Officer, Long Island, under whose jurisdiction Strait Island comes has desired that an undertaking should be given by the Executive Secretary, AAJVS that in case of any damage caused to the adjoining Primary School building, Medical Sub Centre and Guest House while removing the said Gurjan tree it shall not be the responsibility of the Forest Department. In this connection it may kindly be noted that an order under Cr.PC 133 has to be complied in true letter and spirit by the party upon which direction is issued ensuring all measures for safe removal of the dangerous tree or building or any other material as the case may be. No such undertaking can, therefore, be given by the undersigned or Social Worker In-Charge of the AAJVS posted at Strait Island.

You may, therefore, kindly comply with the order of the Sub Divisional Magistrate, South Andaman failing which the undersigned shall be compelled to file a Contempt Petition before the Sub Divisional Magistrate, South Andaman.


