100 Chief Secretary, A&N Administration proposes to visit Jarawa area during mid of October 2009 with senior Officers of the Administration. This issue was also deliberated during the Executive Council meeting of AAJVS. Chief Secretary shall meet the Jarawas in their habitat and review the welfare measures being taken up by Administration.

101 It is proposed that the following Officers may accompany Chief Secretary for the above tour:-

- ✓ a) Secretary (TW)
- ✓ b) Superintendent of Police (South Andaman District)
- ✓ c) Chief Engineer APWD
- ✓ d) Deputy Director (TH)
- ✓ e) Executive Secretary, AAJVS
- ✓ f) Head of Office, Anthropological Survey of India, Port Blair

102 Chief Engineer, APWD is proposed as in many places on ATR, civil works are under going and the contractors dump waste materials like cement bags, empty bitumen drums etc on the road.

103 Instead of going on convoy of cars, it is proposed that the Chief Secretary may go by car and team by a mini bus hired from IP&T. This would avoid delay of time and expenditure. Team may leave Port Blair by early morning to Jarawa camp on the ATR and return back on the same day please.

104 The Tribal Welfare Officer, Kadamtala and his Field Attendants may reach the Jarawa camps to appraise the situation and other issues.
