	245	<p>This is a copy of letter from the Tehsildar, Little Andaman, addressed to Dr. Pronob Kumar Sircar, Research Investigator, AAJVS, Dugong Creek informing that</p> <p>“Hon’ble Justice Miss Nadira Patherya of Calcutta High Court at Port Blair will be visiting Hut bay on 17th September 2011 on Official duty by Sea Plane which is expected to arrive at Ht Bay by 13:00 hrs. In this context, it is kindly requested you to make necessary arrangement for her visit to “Dugong Creek”</p> <p>It is submitted here that Dugong Creek is a tribal reserve area and not a tourist spot for entertainment of the Judicial body. The Tehsildar’s who are posted at Little Andaman has time and again been directing AAJVS Officials for accompanying the dignitaries to visit Dugong Creek which has nothing to do for them. The tribal has been settled by the A&N Administration in remote and far flung areas to preserve their sanctity, culture and tradition. These types of visit are unwarranted and interference into their life.</p> <p>AAJVS has posted two Officials at Dugong Creek and there presence in the settlement is mandatory. During the visit of ES to Dugong Creek, Dr. Sircar informed that his services were utilized by the Tehsildar in Little Andaman for various other purposes including census and election at R.K. Pur and V.K.Pur, liaison duty with District and Sessions Judge, CJM’s etc.</p> <p>In the light of the above paras, it is proposed that we may take up the matter with A&N Administration (Protocol), District Administration and the Registrar of High Court to desist such practices of sending VIPs / VVIPs to primitive tribal areas.</p> <p>Submitted please.</p>
