227	This is a letter from the Divisional Forest Officer, Middle Andaman in response to this office letter dated 3 rd February 2012 copy placed at page 155/C with regards to the conditional order for removal of the dead Gurjan Tree standing dangerously behind the Primary School, at Strait Island.
228	The DFO repatriates that the order of SDM U/s 133 of Cr. PC is a conditional order and not an absolute order. Without giving reasonable opportunity an order U/s 133 Cr. PC cannot be made absolute. In view of this AAJVS is free to file any petition before the competent authority for non-compliance of the conditional order U/s 133 of Cr. P.C.
229	It is submitted here that removal of the dead Gurjan tree lying dangerously positioned behind the School/ Guest House. Medical Sub-Centre at Dugong Creek has been lingering for last many year and in spite of an order from the SDM, no action has been taken. The tree may fall any time leading to irreparable loss of human life as well as Govt property.
230	It is therefore proposed that we may take up the matter with the SDM /ADM for appropriate action for the safety and well being of the citizens residing at Strait Island.
