At the outset, the Secretary (TW) discussed the news item published in the Daily Telegram on 3<sup>rd</sup> July 1998 under the caption "HIGH MORTALITY AMONG ANDAMANESE TRIBE DUE TO MALNUTRITION: ICMR STUDY". The Assistant Director, RMRC informed that the report was based on a study of ICMR during 1995-96 wherein it was pointed out that malnutrition may be responsible for high infant mortality among the Great Andamanese tribe population of which has declined from 3500 in 1858 to 36 in 1995 and the report was sent to only the Science Journal and not to any popular public media.
