A SIGNAL RECEIVED FROM SOCIAL WORKER DUGONG CREEK STATE THAT YOU HAVE BEEN PROVIDED WITH ALL POSSIBLE AMENITIES THAT ARE NEEDED TO SERVE IN THE REMOTEST ISLANDS LIKE DUGONG CREEK (.) BUT IT IS UNFORTUNATE TO HEAR THAT YOU HAVE NOT PAID THE CHARGES OF FOOD YOU HAVE TAKEN FROM 8TH TO 13TH (.) SOCIAL WORKER HAS FURTHER INFORMED THAT YOU HAVE BEEN PROVIDED WITH A DAILY RATED CHOWKIDAR WHOSE SERVICES ARE ALSO BEING UTILISED FOR WASHING OF CLOTHING, CLEANING OF TOILET ETC. EVEN THEN YOU ARE NOT SATISFIED THE REASON OF WHICH IS NOT UNDERSTOOD (.) SEVERE ALLEGATION HAS BEEN BROUGHT AGAINST YOU THAT YOU ARE EXPLOITING ONGES BY ASKING THEM <sup>TO BRING</sup> COCONUT, COCONUT OIL HONEY ETC. AND ALREADY YOU HAVE CARRIED TWO HUNDRED COCONUTS DURING YOUR VISIT TO PORT BLIAR ON 13.8.1998 (.) YOUR EXPLANATION IN THIS MATTER MAY BE SENT TO THE UNDERSIGNED BY SURFACE MAIL FOR FURTHER ACTION IN THE MATTER (.) YOU ARE ALSO INSTRUCTED TO CARRY OUT THE WORK THAT HAS BEEN ENTRUSTED TO YOU WITHOUT CREATING ANY FUTURE CONFUSION (.)
