The Secretary (TW) desired copy of medical history sheet of deceased Togogagei be sent to him by FAB (.) he also observed that she had been suffering from illness since long and died on 20/08/98 due to lack of proper medical attention. He desired that the Medical Officer / staff should take immediate proper and prompt action to provide medical treatment to ailing tribals (.) He also desired that Medical Officer / staff must prepare health card/ chart of all Onges and all other primitive tribes (.) For Tehsildar Little Andaman only (.) Please enquire into the cause of death of Late Togogaei and also enquire whether she was given proper medical aids when she was sick (.) For the staff of AAJVS only (.) Proper care and action should be taken to provide medical aids to ailing tribals by liaisoning with Medical Officers / staff (.)
