Smti. Togogegi expired on 20/08/98. The Medical Officer-in-charge was requested to intimate the cause of death vide signal at page 89/C. The Medical Officer-in-charge has informed that Smti. Togogegi died of old age and she was suffering from Geriatric problem vide his signal No. 71/98 dated 31/08/98 placed at page 90/C.

We have already submitted approval for issue / supply of vegetables to the Great Andamanese. If approved, we may also supply vegetables, banana, eggs to the Onges also. The present population of Onges including South Bay is 102.
