The AAJVS is an autonomous body and funds for the Samiti is provided by Govt. of India, Ministry of Welfare for implementation of various schemes in the form of Special Central Assistance and Grant-in-aid provided by the UT Administration for the strengthening and maintenance of AAJVS. In the particular case amounts of Rs. 1.50 lakhs and Rs. 1.34 lakhs were deposited with E.E. APWD, CD-I for implementation of work in Dugong Creek and South Bay Onge settlement in 1991 as a deposit work. The EE, CD-I could not execute the work due to distance and other various departmental reasons. Actually the funds should have been deposited with EE, APWD, MID, Hut Bay. Since it is a deposit work, the fund is not lapsed and only it is transferred to other division of same department i.e. APWD. As such, the cheques may be again re-deposited with EE, MID, Hut bay to undertake the remaining developmental work in the Onge Settlement as per the fresh estimate submitted by the EE, MID.
