① The Director (TW) vide his signal dated 09/07/97 addressed to Executive Engineer, MID, APWD, Hut Bay has reminded him to carry out quick survey regarding condition of the building at the Onge settlements D/Creek and South Bay and send a report.

② The E.E MID vide his signal dated 24/07/97 at page 1/C had earlier informed that the quarters of Medical Officer at D/Creek is in delapidated condition and require extensive repair to save the structure. He has further stated that the estimate will be submitted by him if required.

③ Meanwhile, it is learnt that a Medical Officer has been posted to D/Creek on duty-cum-tour for 3 months and he has already joined. There is no quarters for him. For the time being he has reportedly been accommodated in the Guest House. Further it is learnt that a team of Medical Department lead by Medical Specialists is to visit D/Creek to carry out Health and Nutritional Survey to the Onges of D/Creek. The above team will comprise 4 persons.

④ It will not be possible to accommodate all the team members in the Guest House if the M.O D/Creek continues to occupy a room in the Guest House (there are only two rooms in the guest house at D/Creek). It is therefore proposed that the E.E MID, Hut Bay may be requested to undertake the repairs of the quarters of M.O of D/Creek on top priority basis pending approval of the estimate.

⑤ A provision of Rs. 1.00 Lakh is available under scheme No. - 2 - welfare programme for the Onges of D/Creek and South Bay towards construction and maintenance of staff quarters. The additional fund required for maintenance of the quarters of the M.O may be made available by re-appropriating the funds or out of overall savings during the current year (1997-98)

⑥ The Secretary (TW) is competent to sanction works to be ^{awarded} ~~avoided~~ to Govt. department upto Rs. 5.00 lakhs at a time.
