

(4) Supply of food items should be continued till they raise their own food and become capable to raise or catch fish or other food items easily from sea for which a time bound programme should be prepared to raise plantation and teach them fishing technique.

(a) Fishing by net be taught first then by line fishing.

(b) Plantation need to be raised at suitable site between the settlement Jarwas reserved area. Banana and other plants planted in saline affected area as we saw on 26.10.97 may not come up. This area is best suited for coconut plantation.

(c) Pig rearing can also be considered.

(5) Gift items need to be packed in small bags (cement size bag) instead of giving in loose.

(6) Irregular food supply may cause problems. We need not supply banana and coconut from Port Blair. It is easily available in Middle ^{Andaman} (Uttra). Quotation for supply of food items (Banana and coconut etc.) from Uttra area be finalized. Due to non-availability of boat, tribal welfare department finding difficulty to arrange food items from Port Blair. This supply can be arranged by Engine Dingi locally available on contract basis. It can be coordinated by an official (Social worker) of Tribal Welfare Department to be ^{located} ~~situated~~ at Uttra.

(7) A Sub-Office of Tribal Welfare Department be established at Uttra to monitor the welfare activities of Jarwas.

(8) Visit to the contact point need to be restricted. An order from the Administration after approval of the Hon'ble Lt. Governor to be issued to person authorised to visit Jarwas. No other persons should visit except without the written approval of Hon'ble Lt. Governor on file.
