Similarly cane baskets of various sizes in sufficient numbers be also provided for keeping their food stuffs. Plastic handbags and baskets of various sizes will also be handy and more desirable than the bags made of Jute material. Jute has the obvious disadvantage of its getting rot and disintegrated and worn out as soon as it comes in contact with water. So bags and baskets made of Jute or coir are not suggested.

Possibility of barter system may also be explored. Jarawas might be collecting honey and other herbs. They may be given incentive to start barter system. How it can be introduced can be studied.

I believe the above suggestions may help in preserving a culture, a race, a society of Jarawas and humanity as a whole.
