shall be mobilized depending on the number of Jarawas visiting.

- b) These Jarawas will be persuaded to get into the motor boat / boats.
- c) These motor boats with the Jarawas will be moved from Uttara Jetty and stationed some distance away in the creek so that the non-tribals are not able to contact the Jarawas.
- d) The gifts like coconuts, etc, in a very limited quantity, will be loaded in the motor boat and the Jarawas will be dropped back at their area. Very limited quantity of gifts are suggested to wean away the Jarawas from their recent habit of coming to settlement area. If they are convinced that they would get very little as gifts after reaching the settlement area, they would not be allured to make frequent visits to settlement area.
- e) Procure approved gift articles locally observing codal formalities.

An imprest fund of Rs.25,000/- is sanctioned by AAJVS to the Pradhan of Uttara Gram Panchayat vide this office order No. 62 dated @.5.98 to meet the expenditure involved in this context.
