[খাঁ] It is pronounced in the same way as [খাঁ] but for a longer duration. It is a long vowel.

[\vec{\vec{a}}] It is a long vowel. It is pronounced like 'a' in apple, 'mat,' hat 'as they are pronounced by Indians.

Besides the vowels mentioned above, nasalisation of vowels marked by the sign [~] on the vowels as in [ã, ã:], etc. will be represented by a 'बिंदु' or अनुस्वार marked on the vowels अ, आ etc. as अं, आं and their pronunciation will be the same as in Hindi.
