

These are, according to the principles of using the Nagari script, 'हलन्त व्यञ्जन' or consonants without any vowels associated with them. Using them for writing in an orthographic system requires the removal of the हलन्त चिह्न and associating with the relevant vowel. In writing the Jarawa language the same orthographic system will be used as in Hindi. In other words the use of मन्त्रास and the representation of संयुक्ताक्षर s will be done in the same way as in Hindi.

With this explanatory note on the sound system of the Jarawa language and the use of the Nagari script for writing the same we may now go through a short list of Jarawa words and sentences.
