

(ii) Negatives are formed by adding the suffix / -ma /

- / mi: ti:tama / 'I do not eat'
- / mitejile ti:tama / 'My relatives do not eat'

(iii) In finitives of purpose are formed by adding the suffix / -la / to the verb

- / ti:ta / 'to eat'
- / ti:tala / 'for eating'
- / li: bitti:ga ti:tala / 'This is bad for eating'
- this bad for eating
- / ha:ka a:ikwa:la / 'For killing the crab'
- crab for killing

Syntax :

a) The order of words in a sentence seem to be subject + object + verb i.e., it is an SOV language

Examples:

- (i) mi: a:vðdiya 'I gave a bow'
- I bow gave
- (ii) mi: co:ne ti:ta 'I ate a banana'
- I banana ate

b) In phrases adjectives follow the nouns they qualify as in

- / kaŋapo toḍgiddo / 'Red cloth'
- cloth red
- / pe:pe hi:ruga/ 'A dark green leaf'
- leaf back or dark green
- / na:po po:ña / 'small fish'
- fish small
