May please peruse <sup>from</sup> notes para -1 onwards regarding Jarawa Contact Expedition to drop gifts of coconuts, banana etc <sup>to Jarawas</sup> on Western coast of South Andaman Islands alongwith Vice - Chairman Zilla - Parishad and Pradhans of the area in addition to usual contact team .With reference to para 1-3 n the gift articles were provided to JPP on 10/4/97 vide following details :

coconut - 380 Nos.  
Banana - 80 Kgs.  
Red cloth- 30 Mtrs.

The articles were dropped by JPP around B ada Balu and Bada Ghumai . Matter was discussed by SP(AP) with Director (TW) & AC(TW) on 30/4/97 and it was stated that articles had been ~~collected~~ - <sup>Picked</sup> up by Jarawas and it may be worthwhile to undertake gift dropping weekly <sup>at least before the onset of monsoon.</sup> Hence it is proposed that coconuts 120 Nos. , banana 100 kgs, Red cloth 10-mtrs and iron scrap 10 kgs. may be provided weekly to Jarawa Protection Force .(1 Jeep. load)

Further a proposal at para 5-6/N was submitted for approval for gift dropping <sup>from</sup> sea side and it was also proposed that Chairman AAJVS - (Hon'ble Lt. Governor , A&N Islands) may like to approve the deployment of MV Tarmugli on 23rd April 1997 for the purpose.
