for action as per the rules prevailing in the Andaman & Nicobar Administration.

The existing official Contact Team may visit the Jarawa areas periodically, say once in a quarter to assess the situation. The Director of Shipping Services is required to provide the suitable vessel for such regular contact expeditions as usual.
