

Most importantly on the same day reportedly at about 0900 hrs near the Jarawa hut of R. K. Nallah from an ambassador car bearing No. AN 988 the Jarawa boy took away a hand bag of a tourist namely- Shri Naveen from Bihar and disappeared which contained a camera and some amounts.
