- (i) Executive Secretary, AAJVS.

These Officers will inspect the working of the Staging Pots and record their observations / suggestions.

There shall be a Committee consisting of public representatives like Pradhan of concerned Gram Panchyat, Surpanch, Member of Panchyat Samiti, Member Zilla Parishad. This Committee shall over see the implementation of various decisions / measures taken by the Administration to tackle the Jarawas problems.

The Task Force consisting of the following shall supervise to ensure the implementation of various decisions relating to the welfare of Jarawas.

- (i) Inspector General of Police.
- (ii) Principal, Chief Conservator of Forests.
- (iii) Secretary (TW)
- (iv) Deputy Commissioner, Andamans.
- (v) Head of Office of ASI.
- (vi) Director of Health Services.
- (vii) Director (TW)
- (viii) Executive Secretary, AAJVS.

The Research and Development Cell consisting of the following shall advise the Administration and the Task Force on continuous basis on all the matters relating to Jarawas:-

- (i) The Director of Anthropological Survey of India.
- (ii) The Director of Central Institute of Indian Languages.
- (iii) The Principal Chief Conservator of Forest, A & N Islands.
- (iv) The Director of Health Services, A & N Administration.
- (v) The Director of Regional Medical Research Centre, ICMR, Port Blair.
- (vi) The Director of Tribal Welfare.
- (vii) The Executive Secretary, AAJVS -- Convenor
