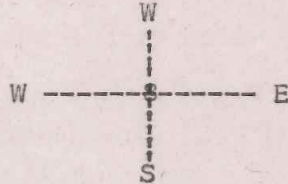


14. Two male children swam a long distance after seeing us come, and boarded the Police Escort Boat which also carried gifts.

SOUTH ANDAMANS

Moved out of the Creek at 1400 hrs. and just after Bluff Cape 6 Jarawas were sighted with two adults carrying baskets. We decided to go on shore. Kakaji, of m.v. Tarmugli was reluctant because of rocky shore. But we did go, though could not land on shore.

Only four Jarawas children all male were seen now. They started swimming towards the boat, boarded it and first collected red cloths.

Thereafter, we gave them 10 Nos. Coconut bags and six Jerry cans full of water, and red cloths.

- Collecting and taking the gifts articles on shore was a Tremendous effort.
- Shri KK Jindal, Director(TW) pointed that one child was contacted in Middle Andaman during December, 95 contact.
- 8 Reaching near the shore they could not lift the 35 Litre Jerry cans.
- They were seen drinking jerry can water, but since they could not lift it. They emptied it in the sea and placed the empty Jerry can on rocks after retaping it.
- Only two elder ones came near the boat. Collected gifts, took it and handed it over to others near the shore.
