The huts were covered with two different types of leaves (actual names we are not able to identify, but the next trip the leaves will be carried and ~~but~~ botanical name will be identified).

IX Material culture

Attempts were made to collect the data on material culture. It is observed that they are rich in material culture. We have seen different kinds of nets, baskets, implements which are used for hunting and gathering. We have observed three types Peroto (fishing nets) used by the Jarawa. The size and shape also varies from one another. The nets are
