XIII Impact of Modernisation / Acculturation

It is observed that there is an impact on the Jarwa. It may be due to the contact by the officials or by the settlers. The impact on material culture is more, i.e. using the plastic containers for carrying water, plastic/nylon threads ~~for~~ in making for fishing nets. It is also observed one Jarwa adult was using plastic sheet as waist guard instead a bark one. We observed ~~some~~ iron implements used by them for cutting, scooping etc. It is also observed few male and female Jarwas using small aluminium ~~knives~~ ^{tied to their glad hanging} at their back of the Jarwas.

It is also noticed they have learnt some Hindi words such as pani (water) Khela (banana).
