researcher demonstrated to children and adult Jarawa to stand on centre of the platform of the weighing machine. Body weight is recorded in kilograms. Stature/height vertex of each individual is recorded in centimeters with steel tape. This measurement is taken while individual is standing in upright posture on plat form of the weighing machine. Steel tape is placed gently on the back of the subject touching one end of the tape plat form of weighing machine and other end of tape is stretched slowly touching highest point on head as far as possible. Circumference of head is measured with tape at nipple line preferably in mid Inspiration in normal condition of the subject. Circumference of chest of girls ~~above~~ 15 yrs and above years and adult women could not be taken for obvious reasons. Circumference of calf is measured at mid point of leg while individual is standing in upright posture. All measurement were took from healthy individuals and free from any kind of body deformities following standard techniques of Jelliffe (1966); Singh and Bhasin (1968).

Before taking measurement on individual subject, their sex and age is recorded. The age is recorded in completed years after observing his/her dentition and through eye estimation. A mark is placed, later, on the upper arm of right Land with ball pen after taking measurement of each individual subject for avoiding duplication.

Researcher could not take measurement on all individuals, during contact expedition for obvious reasart. The Jarawa men and women after receiving
