

Observations :

1. Enmen was present though he had lost some weight.
2. 2 Pregnant ladies were apparantly anemic.
3. Jarawas were seen making advance reservation for gift items by handing over their baskets etc. to staff on subsequent trips of lifeboats to ship and back.
4. Enmen was spotted in Kadamtala 2-3- times in last month but on asking he denied it (perhaps because we were trying to convey that he should not go to Kadamtala). However he confirmed that others had gone.
5. Enmen remembered how to write alphabets. He also displayed phenomenal memory by remembering and recalling details of my family members from his stay at Port Blair including my name.
6. Even very small children 4-6 months were seen slung on the backs of children of 6-7 years of age.
7. Jarawas has constructed temporary lean-to shades in the background.
8. Fornight stay they had made family wise camps on the beach, spread palm leaves for sleeping, boundry marking by way of encirclement by ballis and red flags for individual families in a row facing sea.
9. The group was exactly the same on both days.
10. A very large number of children especially infants confirmed high fertility however linguists observations also pointed to high infant mortality.
11. While describing dead children Jarawas didn't seen to be very emotional.
12. Live Deer/ their Hoof marks and droppings were seen in the area. Bones of one dead deer were also found. Jarawas confirmed that they had killed it and wild pigs ate it.
13. We checked as to whether they eat hermit crabs, Jarawas denied it.
14. The person with ampulated hand didn't allow his bandage to be taken off and wound inspected. Another person with pig bite on hand was bandaged. Child seen with wounds on head last time was all right.
15. One lady was indicating that her infant as sick and the child seemed to be effected by Diarrhea. With the help of CIIL people we tried to convey to give him more water. The native medicine man denied as to whether child had any disease.
