


16. One young lady was all the time sitting separately and doing her own things.
17. In the begining of contact on both days (at the time of distribution of gift articles) most of young children 1-3 yrs. were seen left in the care of one lady at one side.
18. One boy of 'Enmen's' age expressed interest to came to my 'chadda'.
19. Jarawa men were less communicative than children or women and were seen doing their own thing, collecting, dehusking coconuts etc. They also sought help to dehusk coconuts. Coconuts were also segregated on the basis of their tenderness. Jarawas apparantly carry only dehusked coconuts to their huts.
20. Jarawas personal waste disposal was observed. Stool is disposed by way of cleaning with leaf, collecting the leaves in a large leaf, tying it with a vine and <sup>through</sup> ~~through~~ in the jungle. Ladies were seen urinating at a distance and cleaning themselves with a stick after the act.
21. ICMR & ZSI experts took anthropometric data including skin fat fold measurements and observed that females had higher fat deposits.
22. Some children were displaying shyness and hiding in Jungle initially, someother wanted to lead me into the jungle apparantly to show something on 07/11/96 but by then it was late and we could not go inside.
23. Enmen was most of the time in the life boat, he went to the ship, collected some roties and gave to his friends in small pieces which they seemed to like.
