5. The small kinds, about the age of plus 2 playing with two small sticks imitating the shooting of arrows.

6. It is observed that eventhough the Jarawas offering cocount pieces when they are eating, they are grumbling or little bit reluctant if you take coconuts or bananas from the without their consent. May be their idea is that once the things reaching their hand, it becomes their property.

It is found that may of their psychological, emotional and behavioral patter are almost similar with any other civilised humans.

Regular contacts with these Jarawas may certainly help in understanding their problems, way of living and to take necessary welfare measures for their development. The way the administration putting all the affords for understanding the Jarawa tribe is excllent and one day they become more friendly.
