Out of 14 children, there were Four and three infant males and females respectively. Out of 12 women & are pregnant and out of 9 male members, one male member were amputated.

There are 6-7 temporary huts of the Jarawa near the shore. All the temporary huts are almost broken. We spent more than fifteen minutes and observed the huts and habitation. We observed the huts are temporary in nature and about 4ft, on height, about 4/5ft in length and about  $3\frac{1}{2}$ ft in breadth. The side are open the huts are thatched with palm leaves. All the gift items were collect by the Jarawas and store near the Jungle with the help of net and basket. A group of Jarawa about 7-8 individuals met us & they embrace us with great joy and expressed so many things in their our views by gesture.

We observed their morphological characters behaviours and some aspect on material culture etc. Majority of the female and children smeared their face with white and red ochre. Women and children wear armlets, waist belt made of locally available leaves. Both male and female use necklacers. It is
