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observed that 3-4 young Jarawa girls were a head band like thing which was prepared with palm leaves. It is perhaps used for the beautification of their body. They were sitting in a group before a fine-place under the tree. The food items which were given to them to as presentations such as banana, coconuts, ripe banana which were taken by them without boiling or roasting ? but green one's were consumed after boiling. Shell which were collected by them from the sea were also consumes after boiling the same. A man was also preparing a bow and one female Jarawa was also making a net, which will be used for collection of presantation articles and for the purpose of fishing. The doctor treated their wounds and applied some medicine. He also measured their weight and hight and some nutritional measurement for their nutritional status. We tried to make them pick up some Hindi vocabularies in order to maintain for contact smothly in future. With the help of linguistic I have also collected some of their language which are given below :-

1. Mifejile = Friend
2. gegah, Alema = come tomorrow morning.
3. Iine = out sider.
4. Dag = coconut.
5. choonea = Banana.
