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developed fire adjacent to the demarcation point. Some families collected fish and they boiled with the sea water. They removed scales and fins of the fish. One adult male member is suffering with high temperature and body pain. So he did not participate to collect gift items. From their gesture, its observed that most of them are suffering with cough and cold. It is also observed that Jarawa's are quite concious about their hygiene practices. For instant during the ~~contact~~ contact a infant boy pass his motion of a sudden in his ~~mother~~ mother lap. Immediately the mother took her baby in the sea and wash his axes with sea water. This instant clearly show that the Jarawa do wash their anus after passing stool. They were very happy. Majority of the males and females Jarawa smeared their faces with white and red ochre. Women and children wears armlets, wristbelt made of locally available leaves. All the Jarawa are wears Head band and armlets made of local flower. The doctor applied medicine in their wounds. We left Yadita point and came back to Tarmugli at 2.30 PM. And after hald an hour ship started towards Kadamtala jetty and halt.

On the next day morning of 13.2.97 at 7 AM Tarmugli anchored near the Spike Island. The Jarawa are waiting for Contact party. The team carried, coconut banana, iron, red cloth as gift articles. The Jarawa are collected gift items from life boat. During this visit we met 46 members of Jarawa including male, female and children.
