on shore of the island after noticing few tribesmen moving on the shore under assumption that tribesmen would collect gifts from the spot. After keeping gunny bags on the shore, team members threw several coconuts from live boat in the sea under assumption that the tribesmen may come near to liveboat for gifts. Even then, the tribesmen did not come near to live boat, but collected coconuts with adze by rowing indigeneous canoe. The entire contact with the Sentinelese in other may be stated as "distant contact with the Sentinelese tribesmen".

The team members in the evening of 11 Feb. 1997 started their journey to Middle Andaman to establish friendly contact with Jarawa on 12 Feb. & 13 Feb. 1997. The team members met 43 individuals at Foul Bay and 46 individuals at Spike Island on 12 February & 13 Feb., 1997 respectively. The details are as follows :
