the Jarawa for about 3 hours. We left Spike Island and came back to Tarmugli at 11 A.M.

On the way a group of Jarawa are waiting for the contact party at Lakralungta point. After half an hour the boat again started towards Lakralungta point with a full of gift items. Seeing the contact team the Jarawa are dancing and some of them jumped into the life boat to collect gift items. They were very much excited when we reached the shore. All the gift items collected from boat and kept km near the jungle. They are 14 numbers.

M - 3 (Adult) - 3 children.

F - 5 (Adult) - 3 children.

This contact party wait some time and observed their activities. One girl was engaged in knitting small handy nets with different colours and design. The Jarawa boy 'Enmen' was very happy to our arrival, We tried to make them pick up some Hindi words to maintain for contact in future. With the help of 'Enmen' myself and Dr. Rao collected some of their language.
