It is also discussed to find out the feasibilities as to whether the Jarawas coming to Tirur could be immediately shifted somewhere beyond Jerkatang No. 2 in a vehicle and provide them the items there so that they may stop coming to the populated areas of civilized population of South Andaman.

3. The Secretary (TW) expressed his concern over the News item published in the Andaman Herald on 08/10/98 that the AAJVS and TW Department were unaware of the visit of Jarawas to Uttara which was not a fact. He also pointed out the news item that only one woman Jarawa patient discharged from GB Pant Hospital send back to the habitat (Lakra Lungta) on 06/10/98 by the police while as a matter of fact all 15 Jarawas were taken to their habitat in a police boat by the Executive Secretary, AAJVS. The Secretary (TW0 directed the Executive Secretary, AAJVS to send a rejoinder to the Editor, Andaman Herald.
