

(89)	<p>The proposals of Director (TW) at para 72-74/N have been approved by the Chairman, AAJVS (Hon'ble Lieutenant Governor, A &amp; N Islands) which includes appointment of staff on contract basis and procurement of vehicle. The proposals are furnished as under :-</p> <p>I) Since there is more pressure on SHO, Kadamtala and Tribal Welfare Officer, Uttara, 3 unskilled persons are to be engaged on contract basis. One person Shri Bibhuti Biswas has been assisting the Tribal Welfare Officer since September 1998 when the Jarawa patients were admitted in the PHC, Kadamtala. Two more persons may be engaged on contract basis</p> <p>II) Jarawas are more frequently coming on the ATR road and they stop the vehicles and get into the vehicles and go to Middle Strait which is very serious matter at it may cause mishap. It is very much essential to depute staff to regulate the Jarawas. An experienced and two supporting unskilled persons are to be engaged on contract basis. They may be given a vehicle for patrolling in the ATR to regulate the movement of Jarawas. When we appointed Tribal Welfare Officers, 2 candidates were on panel i.e. Miss V. Leena and Shri Mohammed Israil. As per the provisions, Miss V. Leena is to be engaged as she is on first position but it would be better if a male candidate is engaged which may kindly be decided. However, we may give offer to both of them. For patrolling a vehicle is must, at present we have a Gypsy at Headquarters and a commander jeep for Jarawa contact expeditions. The Hon'ble Lieutenant Governor, A &amp; N Islands has already approved the proposal for procurement of a van, till the van is procured, the commander jeep may be used for this purpose. We may procure a van TATA - 407 as proposed at para 82/N. The model of the van is placed at page 218/C.</p> <p>III) The Jarawas of South Andaman are also visiting the villages frequently and to assist the police personnel at least 2 unskilled persons are to be engaged on contract basis. One person has already been engaged with the approval of the Secretary (TW) and one more person is to be engaged. In the meeting held in the Chamber of Secretary (TW) with the PRI members on 05/01/99, in connection with visit of Jarawas it has been decided to appoint one Shri Kishore Kumar. He may be engaged on contract basis.</p> <p>Submitted for approval PI.</p>
