

(a) Continue the enrichment programme by way of raising plantation in the identified Jarawa areas like Potatang etc. Sea and Sea Creek Ranching, teaching of fishing by use of fishing net are also to be continued.

(b) It is not desirable for the present to uproot the Jarawas from their land and rehabilitate / settle in an isolated island.

(c) Locate water sources in the Jarawa areas and improve them wherever necessary with a view to ensure the availability of drinking water even during the dry seasons.

(d) Establish Staging Posts at identified places like Potatang, Middle Strait, Kadamtala and Tirrur etc. These Staging Posts shall be the hub of activities meant for the welfare of the Jarawas. Each Staging Posts could be staffed by the required personnel like :-

(vi) Strengthen the men and material of Police and other concerned Departments including AAJVS etc.

(vii) Public representatives in the form of Committees could oversee the activities of the officials in the Jarawa welfare measures.

(viii) Intensify the patrolling on the Andaman Trunk Road to prevent road accident involving the Jarawas.

(ix) Without waiting for the Jarawa Hand Book being published / printed, copies of the manuscript could be given to the officials / workers to enable them to communicate with the Jarawas.

(x) Compensation to be paid by Administration in cases of considerable losses due to the plundering by the Jarawas.
