

The Jarawas and Sentinelese Contact
Expedition was organised by the Administration
from 2nd May to 3rd May, 1993. The Contact
Team was led by Dr. Sanat Kaul, Chief Secretary.

The team established friendly contact with Jarawas of Middle Andaman Island on 2.5.93. The gifts like coconut, bananas were given to the Jarawas. The Skin Specialist from the G.B. Pant Hospital accompanied the team who examined the sores frequently found on the body of the Jarawas. The treatment was also given to the Jarawas. The team was with the Jarawa Group for about 3 hours and made certain observations including recording of the voices of the Jarawas. There were 45 Jarawas with 21 males and 24 females

team praceeded to North Sentinel Island and established friendly contact with the gentineless of North Sentinel Island on 3.5.93. The contact was established with two groups of Sentineless. The Sentineless came on board of Life boat of M.V. Tarmugli in which the Contact Team sailed to the shore of North Sentinel Island. The Sentineless collected coconut gift from the Life Boat happily. The Contact Team also landed on the shore and gave away the coconut to the Sentineless. It was found that the Sentineless were very happy to receive the coconut gifts. The women and children also
