

hutments so that the same are saved from wild bores till they get ^{rooted} ~~fruits~~, but also experiment more thoroughly the planting of such fruit bearing trees by air spray by the Forest Department. There does exist a scheme for the same with the Forest Department. (68) (8)

It may be of help to have frequent discussions with the experts in the field specially the representatives of Anthropological Survey of India. The Director (TW) has already been advised to ~~the~~ ^{mark} take action for convening/organising a conference of experts from all over the country to discuss and develop the future policy toward the primitive tribes as was decided in the Executive Council meeting of the AAJVS held recently.
