

(e) Material culture & Artefacts :-

(

- i. Daggers, armlets of cane leaves and flowers, choppers, Bark straps child carrier, fishing baskets, waist girdles head bands, necklaces of shells and flowers.
- ii. A few onge like baskets with one or two decorative lines of cane strips in it.
- iii. Fishing basket made of fibre with rim made of cane was very strong to carry 25-35 coconuts at a time.
 - iv. Alien material culture found viz chain with cross, fishing net or mosquito net, a small knife hanged on back made of aluminium, 10-12 numbers of 'Davs' in good condition.
 - v. Wearing woven threads made of Red cloth and some other plant fibers.
 - vi. 'Dav' was being handled very dexterously and complete coconut kernel was taken out without a crack.

(6) OTHERS OBSERVATION :-

- i. Mostly young babies were carried by childrens.
- ii. After collection of gifts they divided into separate groups around a fire.
- iii. All rushed to the dinghi to collect gifts creating a sort of choos.
 - vi. But no quarrel while collecting the gifts except for one old man holding one young man from back with the intention to restrict his movements. The young one was quite and not countering the old man.
