It is reported by the In- Charge, AAJVS of the Jarawa reserve area that joint patrolling against poaching activities is not being carried out at Jarawa reserve area.

In this regard it is to mention that a decision was taken in a meeting held in the Chamber of Secretary (TW) on 19.04.2006 for curbing poaching activities and to ensure that plenty of food resources are available for Jarawas.
