Sub: Construction of Hotspot for the welfare of Jarawas- reg.

Sir,

I am directed to state that the Group of Expert constituted by the A & N Administration in association with AAJVS is conducting a research on collection of empirical data on the Jarawas. As per their suggestions of the Group of Expert 08 nos hotspots have been identified as a delivery centre for the Jarawas. The identified locations for the hotspots are at Tirur, Jhaukona, Bada Balu, Potatang, Lakra Lungta, Bulf island and Louis inlet Bay etc. These hot spot shall monitor the activities of Jarawa tribes & all the spots are in the Jarawa Reserve area.

During the Executive Council meeting of AAJVS held on 19.04.2013 under the chairmanship of Chief Secretary, A & N Administration, this issue was discussed in detail and directed to construct the hotspot on the above places immediately for better delivery mechanism based on the movement of the Jarawas.

In order to construct / establish the hotspot on the above said places, the AAJVS staff shall require minor forest produces (bamboo & bullies etc) from the Jarawa Reserve areas which may be allowed without hindrance.
